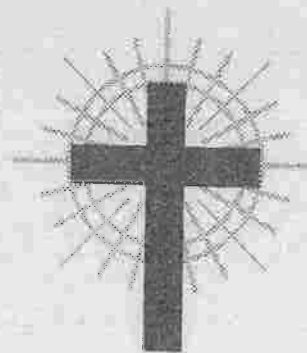

Kept the folded grave-clothes where thy body lay

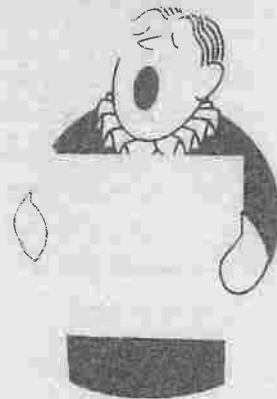
*Thine be the glory risen conquering Son
