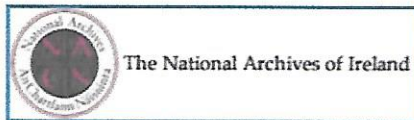

HANN, PATRICK. Reg. No. 18933. Rank, Private, Royal Dublin Fusiliers, 8th Batt.; killed in action, France, September 9, 1916; born Killevan, Co. Monaghan.

HANN, WILLIAM. Reg. No. 7844. Rank, Private, Connaught Rangers, 1st Batt.; killed in action, Mesopotamia, January 21, 1916; born St. Peter's, Dublin.

HANNA, ALEXANDER. Reg. No. 17827. Rank, Rifleman, 13th Royal Irish Rifles; killed in action, France, July 1, 1916; born Lambeg, Co. Antrim.

HANNA, ALEXANDER. Reg. No. 20914. Rank, Rifleman, 12th Royal Irish Rifles; died of wounds, France, September 15, 1918.

HANNA, ARCHIBALD McMILLAN. Reg. No. 12892. Rank, Rifleman, Royal Irish Rifles, 15th Batt.; killed in action, France, July 1, 1916; born Shankhill, Co. Antrim.

HANNA, C. H. W. Rank, Lance-Corporal, Canadian Infantry; died, April 9, 1918; born Ireland; age 34.

HANNA, CHARLES. Reg. No. 745394. Rank, Private, Canadian Regiment; killed, November 6, 1917.
