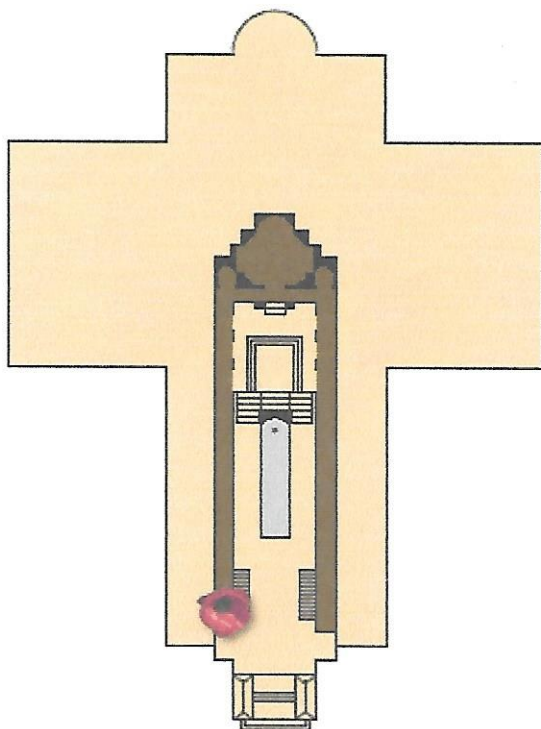

### Location on the Roll of Honour

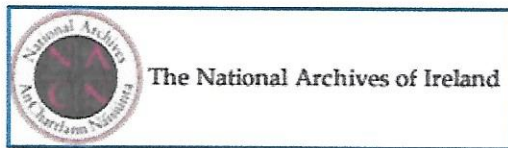
William Henry Taylor's name is located at **panel 1** in the Commemorative Area at the Australian War Memorial .

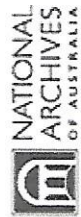

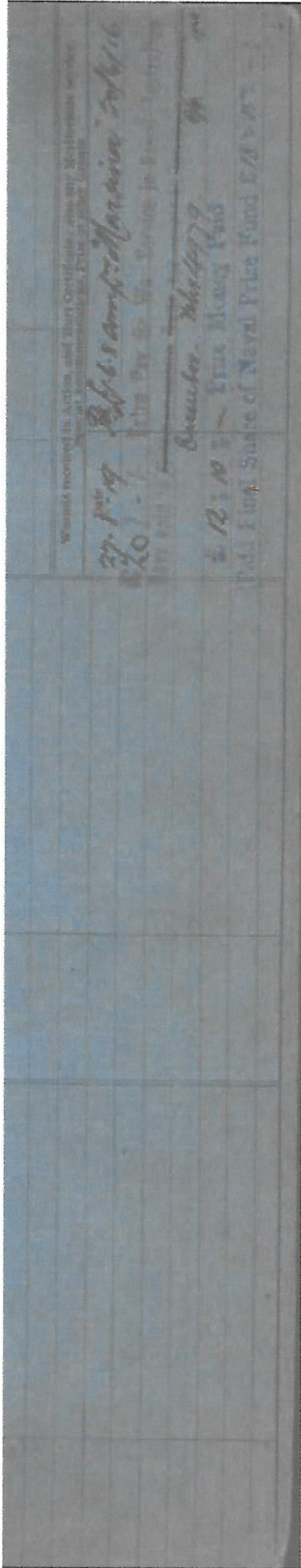
